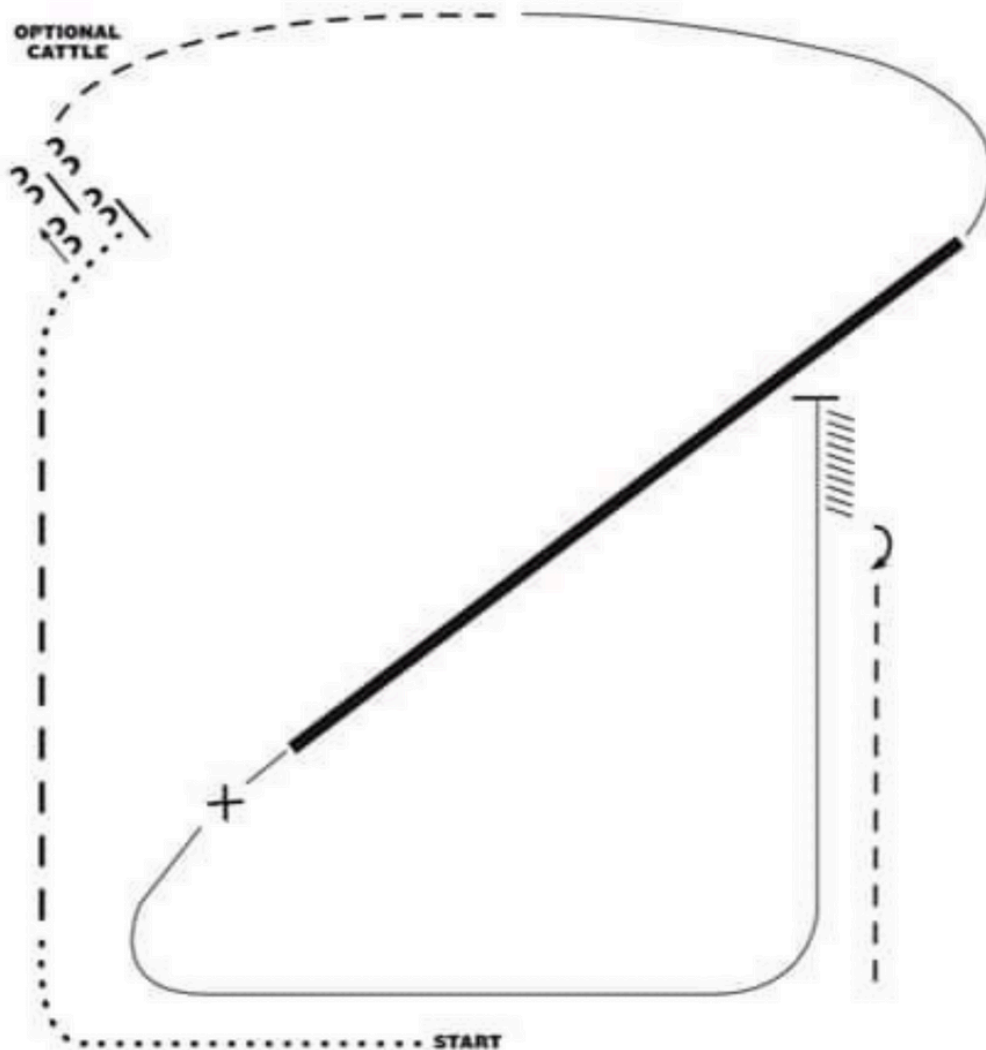

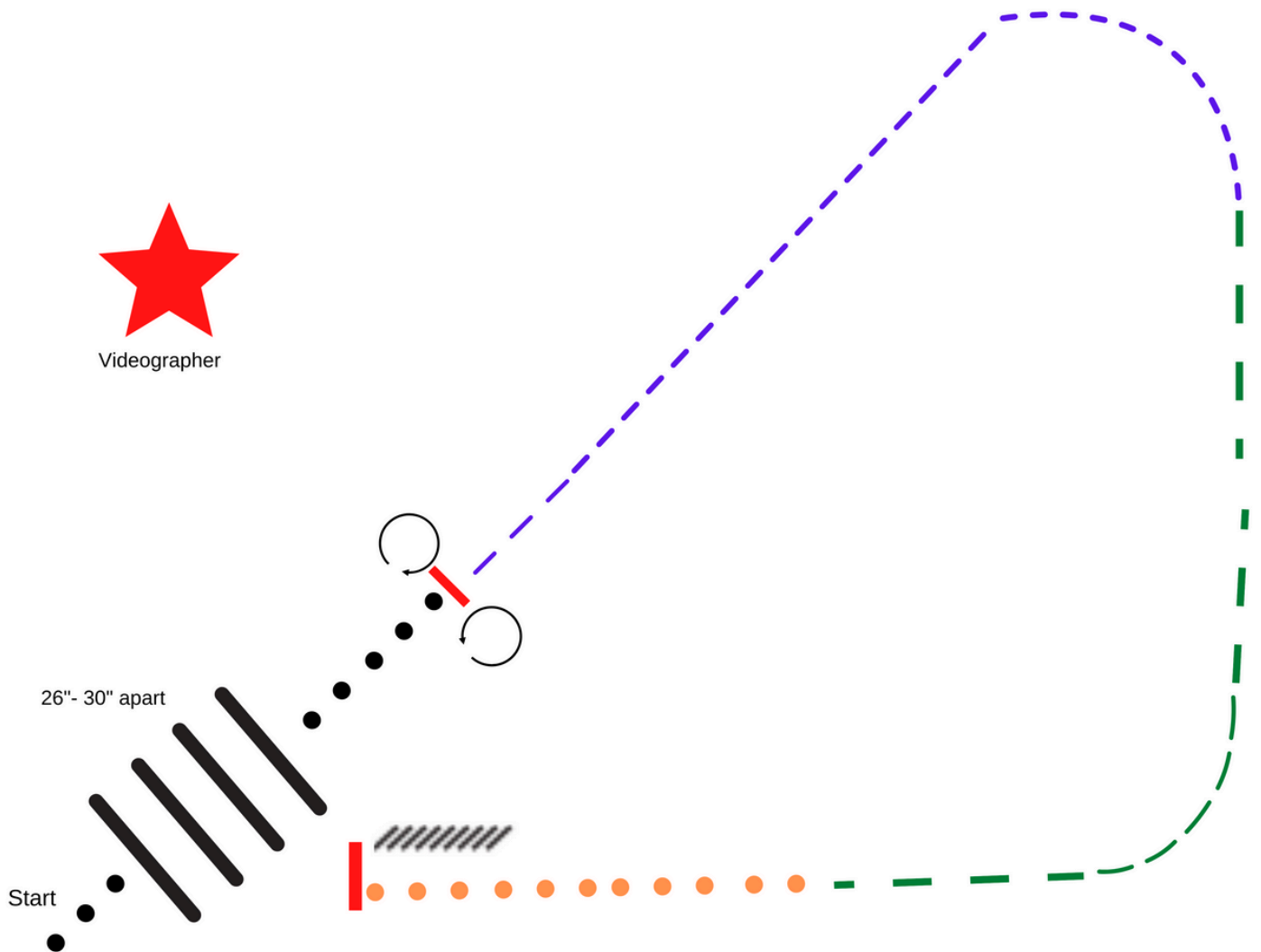

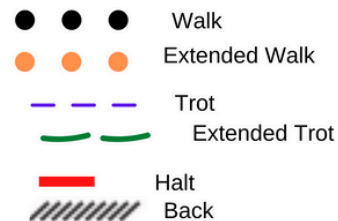

2. Extended trot
3. Walk

9. Lope left lead
10. Stop and back
- II. 180 turn to right
12. Trot

Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Exhibitors should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.

1. Start: Walk and walk over ground poles.
2. Halt and perform 360 degree turn both directions (either R then L, or L then R)
3. Trot
4. Transition to Extended Trot.
5. Transition to Extended Walk.
6. Halt.
7. Back at least 8 steps.
8. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.

Please video Landscape/Horizontal (please NOT PORTRAIT). Make sure the judge can visibly see the horse and rider.**

- 1. TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 2. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 3. Transition to Left Lead LOPE (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 4. Transition to EXTENDED LOPE (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 5. Transition to WALK (for 5-10 seconds)**
- 7. Change directions at the Walk**

#### **NOW TRACKING RIGHT**

- 8. EXTENDED Walk (for 5-10 seconds)**
- 9. Transition to WALK (5-10 seconds)**
- 10. Transition to Right Lead LOPE (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 11. Transition to EXTENDED LOPE (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 12. Transition to TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 13. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 14. HALT along the rail**
- 15. Back 8 Steps**

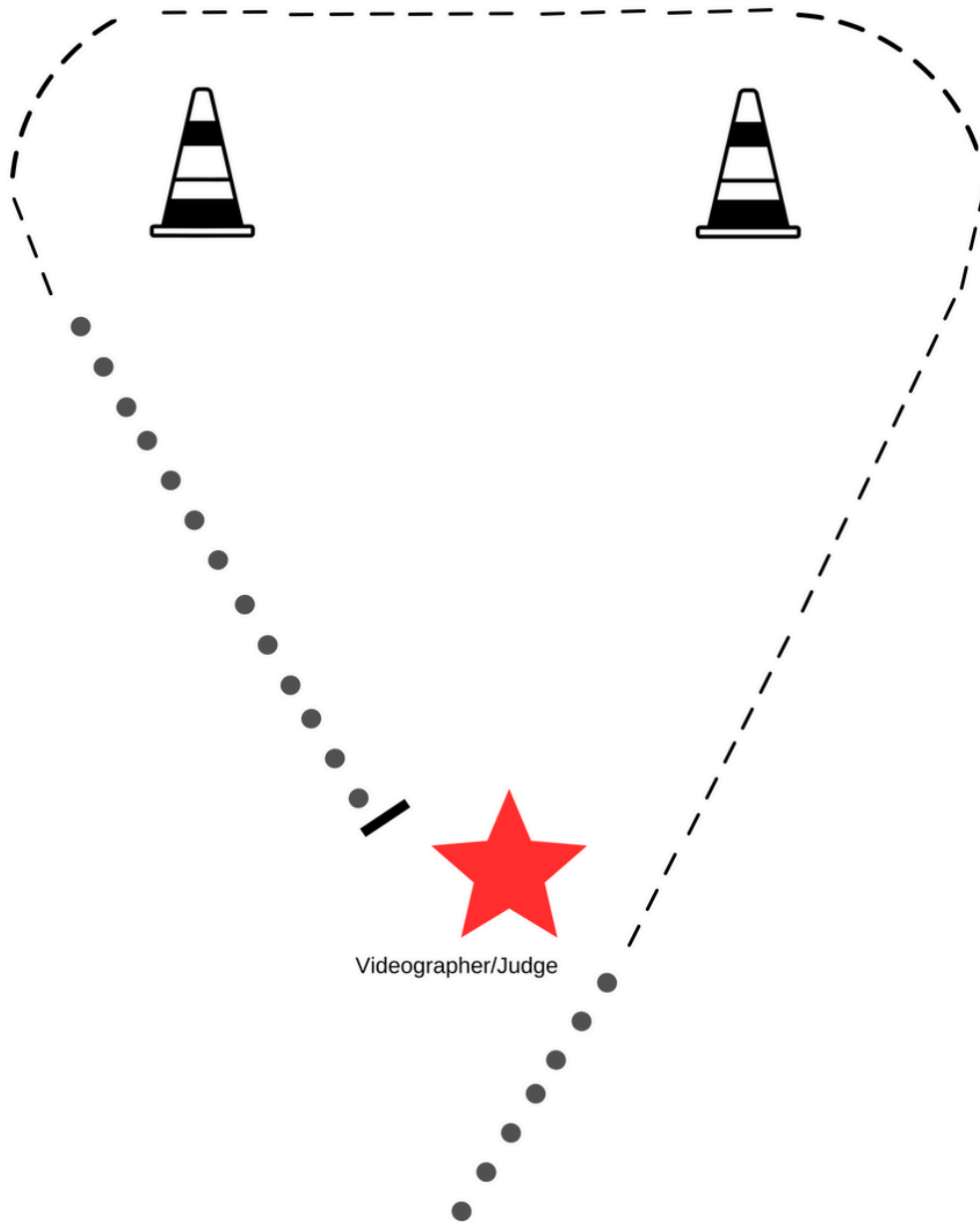

**START TRACKING LEFT:**

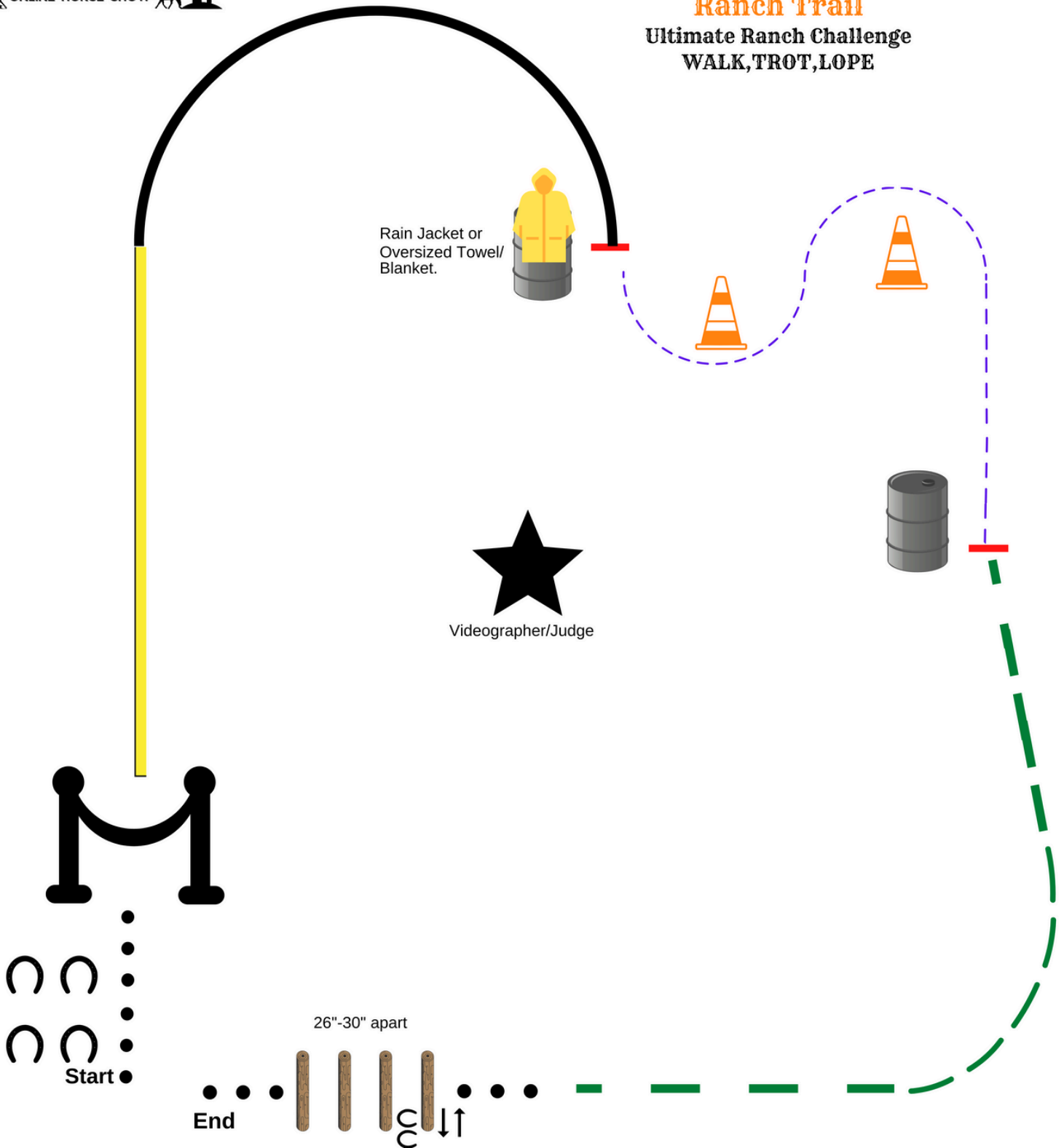
- 1. EXTENDED WALK (5-10 seconds)**
- 2. TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 3. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 4. Transition to TROT (for 10-15 seconds)**
- 5. Transition to WALK (for 5-10 seconds)**
- 6. Change directions at the walk**
- 7. NOW TRACKING RIGHT- Walk (for 5-10 seconds)**
- 8. Transition to EXTENDED WALK (5-10 seconds)**
- 9. Transition to TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 10. Transition to EXTENDED TROT (for 20-25 seconds)**
- 11. HALT along the rail**
- 12. BACK 8 steps**
- 13. Hesitate to show completion of class**





1. Walk straight toward Videographer.
2. Once you get past videographer, trot away.
3. Trot around first cone to second cone.
4. Once around second cone, walk straight toward videographer.
5. Halt in front of videographer.
6. Set Up for inspection.
7. Videographer, while including the whole horse in the video, walk around the horse twice. Please make sure you are not too close and that the video includes the whole horse as you walk around.

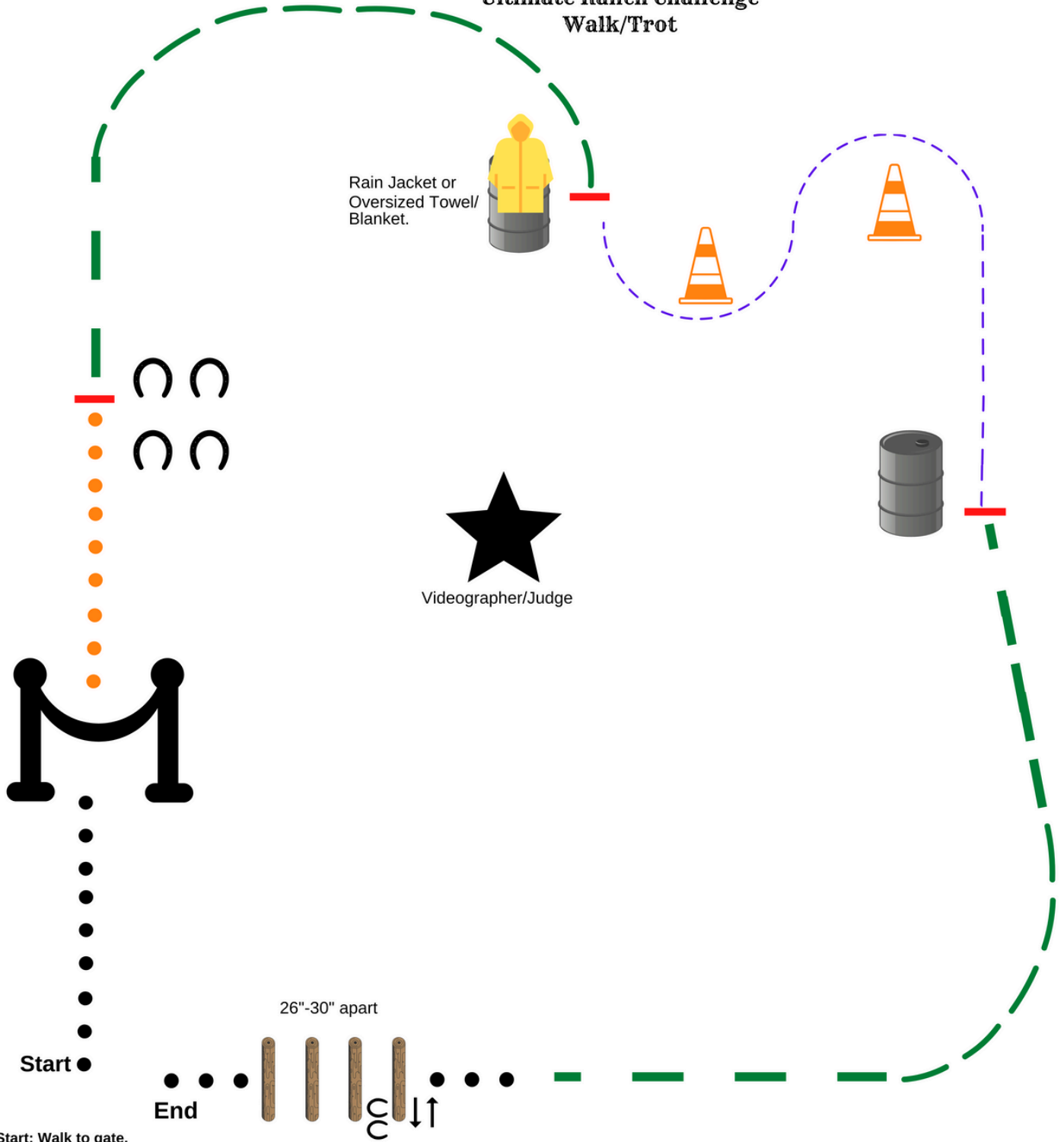


1. Start on the Ground. Ground Tie and Walk around the horse's rear and pick up the horse's right front hoof.
2. Walk around the back of the horse's rear, gather your reins and mount the horse. You may use a mounting block to mount.
3. Walk to gate.
4. Open gate, walk through and close.
5. Lope EXTENDED Right Lead.
6. Transition to Lope.
7. Halt and pick up rain slicker/large towel/blanket.
8. Normal Trot. Trot serpentine around cones to barrel.
9. Halt and discard rain slicker/large towel/blanket.
10. Extended Trot around corner.
11. Transition to Normal Walk.
12. Halt in the middle of the first pole and side pass to the left.
13. Side pass to the right and halt in the middle of the pole.
14. Walk over poles.
15. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.

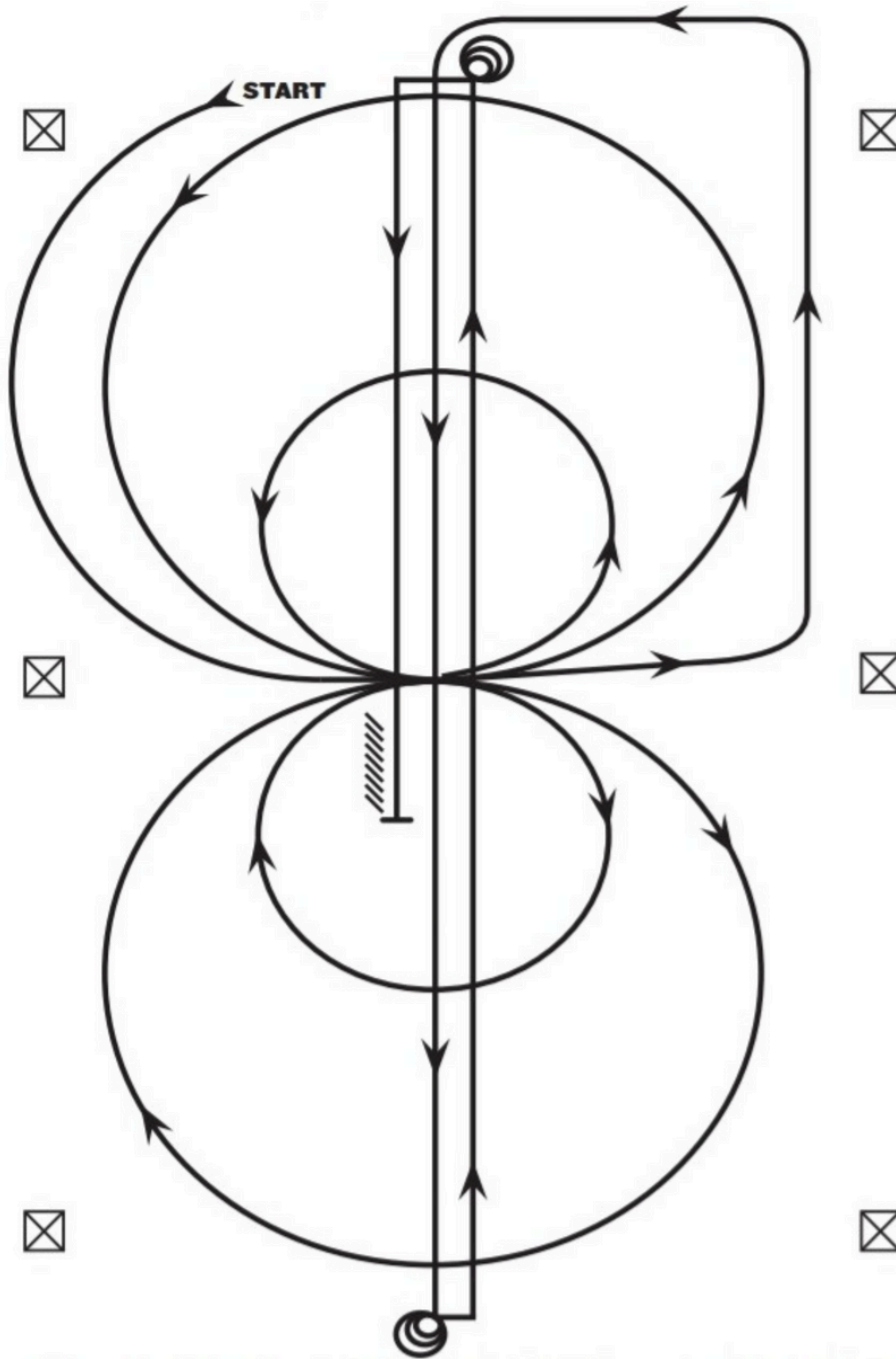
Ultimate Ranch Challenge  
Walk/Trot



1. Start: Walk to gate.
2. Open gate, walk through and close.
3. Extended Walk.
4. Halt and Dismount. You may use a mounting block.
5. Ground Tie and Walk around the horse's rear and pick up the horse's right front hoof.
6. Walk around the back of the horse's rear, gather your reins and mount the horse. You may use a mounting block to mount.
7. Extended Trot half circle.
8. Halt and pick up rain slicker/large towel/blanket.
9. Normal Trot. Trot serpentine around cones to barrel.
10. Halt and discard rain slicker/large towel/blanket.
11. Extended Trot around corner.
12. Transition to Normal Walk.
13. Halt in the middle of the first pole and side pass to the left.
14. Side pass to the right and halt in the middle of the pole.
15. Walk over poles.
16. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.

## September-Ranch Reining



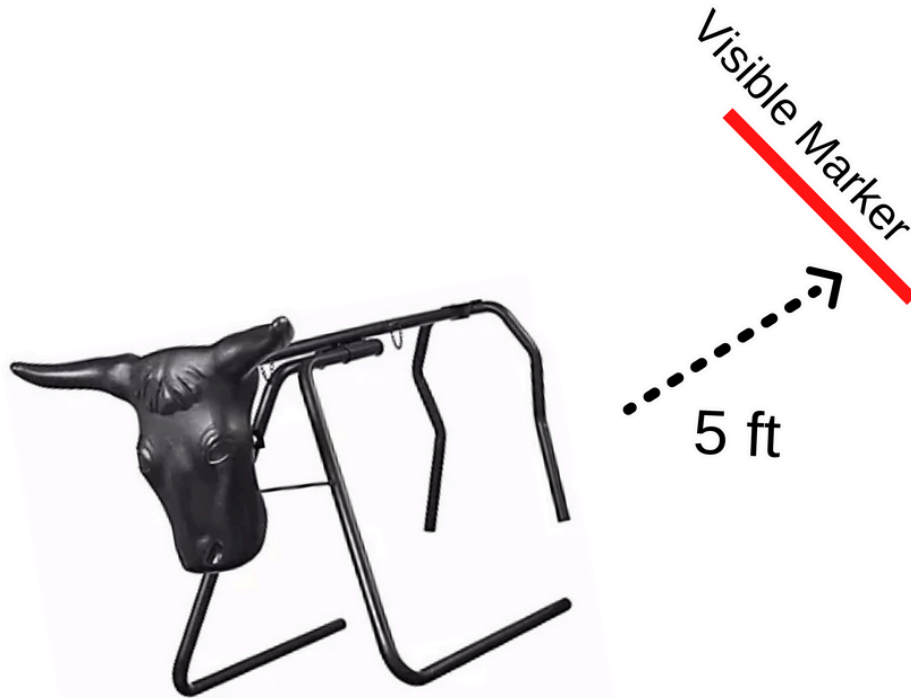
Videographer

Start on left lead. At the center, without stopping or breaking gait, begin pattern facing away from judge.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete 2 circles to the left; the first circle small and slow, the second circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of arena.
2. Complete 2 circles to the right; the first circle large and fast, the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of arena.
3. Continue around end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down center of arena past end marker, and execute a sliding stop.
4. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left.
5. Run down center of arena past end marker, and execute a sliding stop.
6. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right.
7. Run down center of arena past center marker, and execute a sliding stop. Back up at least 10 feet. Hesitate to complete pattern.

Dummy Roping  
\*on foot. not on horse\*  
Ultimate Ranch Challenge  
Both Divisions



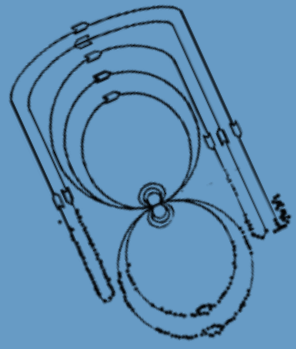
Videographer  
The Dummy Steer is  
on the Videographers  
left side.

- Video please record horizontally. The video must include the contestant and roping steer in the shot. The video must be continuous footage throughout all 5 throws.
- Contestants must stand and throw behind a visible marker (rope, tape, etc) that is 5 feet from the roping dummy (measuring from the tail end of the dummy and 5 ft back). If the contestant steps over the marker then that catch will result in a zero.
- Each contestant will throw 5 loops.
- Legal catches and points:
  - Around both horns +3 points
  - Half head (1 horn and nose) +2 points
  - Neck +1 point.
- After EACH CATCH videographer please walk up to the roping dummy's head to confirm if it is a legal or illegal catch. If we can not see visibly then we will assume it was not a legal catch.
- No figure eights on horns or nose/horn, no roping entire dummy and no fishing allowed.

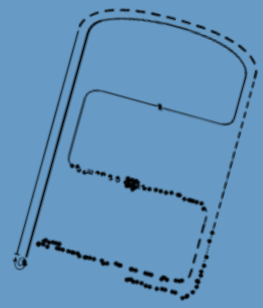
